STATEMENT BY INDIA

Madam President,

India warmly welcomes the delegation of Haiti on the occasion of the adoption of the Report of the Working Group on their Universal Periodic Review. We commend the efforts made by Haiti to participate in the UPR process even in the backdrop of daunting challenges posed by the aftermath of the devastating earthquake.
