## <u>UPR of COLOMBIA – INTERACTIVE DIALOGUE</u> <u>INTERVENTION BY INDIA</u>

Mr. President,

My Delegation would like to take this opportunity to welcome the distinguished delegation of Colombia and thank them for their informative presentation. We have particularly taken note of the candid and frank approach adopted by Colombia in the presentation of their National Report. We also appreciate the efforts of the Government of Colombia to carry out an inclusive process in the preparation of this report by taking into consideration a wide variety of views at all levels.

We welcome, in particular, two initiatives taken in the recent past by the government of Colombia – one, the National Plan for Education in Human Rights implemented by the Ministry of education and two, the Integral policy for human rights and international humanitarian law for the Armed Forces adopted by the Ministry of Defence.
